NOTES: 1. FTE (full-time equivalent) = Fall Undergraduate hours divided by 15, graduate-1 (master's level) hours divided by 12, and graduate-2 (doctoral level) hours divided by 9. The divisors 15, 12 and 9 are considered the standard credit course load taken by a full-time student at the under-graduate, master's and doctoral level respectively. Each first professional student is counted as one FTE. Includes health sciences and first professional students. Includes all students enrolled on campus and off-campus.

2. Two year institutions converted from quarter to semester system Fall 1998, except Southern Union CC which converted Fall 2000.

3. Historical numbers are changed to reflect mergers. See explanation in Appendix i (1).

4. Walker College merged from a private institution with UAB in 1994-97; is included in Beville State CC.

5. Alabama Aviation & Technical College merged with Wallace CC-Dothan in 1998; Sparks St. Technical College merged with Wallace CC-Dothan in 2000.
